

## Housing Acts (Northern Ireland) 1890-1977 Cromac Street, Belfast, Redevelopment No. 18

### Extinguishment of Public Rights-of-Way Order No. 3

## Northern Ireland Housing Executive

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Northern Ireland Housing Executive in pursuance of its powers under the Housing Act (Northern Ireland) 1961 and the Housing Executive Act (Northern Ireland) 1971 on the 6th September, 1978, made an Order which will be submitted to the Department of the Environment for Northern Ireland, for approval ordering that the Public Rights-of-Way described in the Schedule hereunder be extinguished.

A Copy of the said order and of the map (dated 6th September, 1978) referred to therein may be inspected at the principal office of the Northern Ireland Housing Executive, 1 College Square East, Belfast, BT1 6BQ, at all reasonable times.

The Housing Act (Northern Ireland) 1961 provides that the Order shall not have effect until approved by the said Department and that an order to which any objection is made and not withdrawn shall not be approved until a public local inquiry is held into the matter.

Any objection to the order must be made (in writing) stating the grounds of objection and addressed to the Secretary, The Department of the Environment for Northern Ireland, Housing Division, Stormont, Belfast BT4 3SS, before the 31st day of October, 1978.
